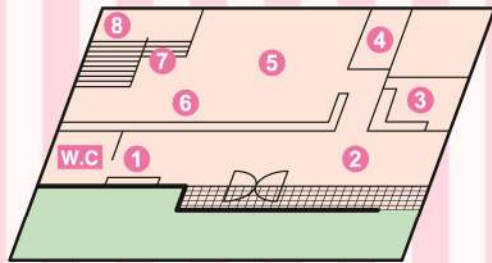


倉敷 Kurashiki YUMIKO IGARASHI MUSEUM

Timeless admiration of girls existing only here in the world

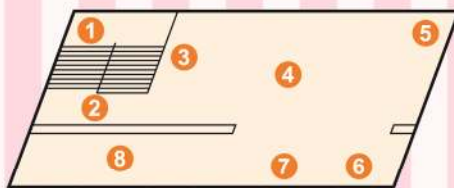

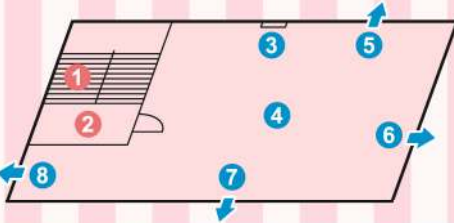
